

General Regulations

- ◆ All fires must be attended by at least one person 16 years of age or older
- ◆ Hose attached to water source or Fire extinguisher must be at hand to control fire
- ◆ Only dry materials may be burned to prevent excessive smoke.
- ◆ All burning is prohibited when wind is greater 10 MPH
- ◆ Fire must not be within 10 feet of any structure
- ◆ Flammable liquids beside starter fluid are prohibited.
- ◆ Burning in any ditch or drainage way is prohibited
- ◆ No fire shall be started any later than 1/2 hour before sunset
- ◆ Consideration for neighbors should be considered with smoke.

Burning in the following situations is regulated or

- ◆ Open Burning
 - Fires shall not exceed 4ft
 - Only charcoal, untreated wood, yard waste, and non-treated paper may be burned
- ◆ Burn Barrel Fires
 - Only dry paper, leaves, or untreated wood may be burned
 - Top of barrel must be covered with screen
- ◆ Burning of construction waste
 - Burning of any construction materials is strictly prohibited
- ◆ Burning of salvage
 - Burning of salvage is strictly prohibited
- ◆ Burning of marsh , large area of grass, large camp fires over 4ft in diameter
 - Fires larger than 4ft of grass land or brush must be reported to Winnebago Communications Center.
 - Report address, phone number, and name of person burning
 - Winnebago Communications Center must be contacted upon completion.
- ◆ Burning of garbage, hazardous materials, or tires
 - Burning of garbage, tires, and hazardous materials is prohibited.
